**FIRST BATCH OF DONATIONS SENT TO THE PHILIPPINES**

Thirty (30) boxes of assorted donated food items and toiletries for the victims of Typhoon Ondoy were sent to the Philippines **today, 3 October**, courtesy of the Philippine Air Lines (PAL) and with the help of SEABRA Movers, Co.

The boxes were consigned to the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), National Resource Operation Center at Chapel Road, Pasay City.

**The Embassy reiterates that DONATIONS of used clothing will no longer be accepted.** Instead of used clothing, donors may choose to give any of the following, which had been identified by the DSWD as “priority relief needs”:

- Medicines (preferably non-prescriptive)
- Food (e.g. canned food, noodles)
- Flashlight
- Mats
- Emergency Lamps
- Blankets
- Tents
- Generators
- Water Containers
- Bath soap
- Baby diapers
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Slippers
- Laundry bars
- Sanitary napkins
